(HOLDREGE, Neb.) -- The Central Nebraska Public Power and Irrigation District has announced that a hydrocycling period has begun at the Johnson No. 2 Hydroplant and will run through April 30.

During this period, Johnson Lake's level typically fluctuates up to two feet as operations are adjusted to minimize the chance of significant flow changes in the Platte Rivers. Hydrocycling takes place each spring and fall as required by an agreement with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Services.
