### Toxic Blue-Green Algae: Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality (NDEQ) Water Sampling Results from Johnson Lake

(HOLDREGE, Neb.) – Water samples taken at Johnson Lake over the past two weeks have indicated a decline from 8.13 parts per billion (ppb) on July 23 to 0.93 ppb on July 30. A reading of 20 ppb triggers a health alert by NDEQ. The NDEQ sample was taken near the swimming beach on the southeast corner of the lake.
