INFORMATION STATIONS

Property Acquisition

The Property Acquisition station provides information related to the land that needs to be acquired for this Project, the rights of each property owner, and the process Central is following to acquire the land.

Engineering

The engineering station provides information regarding the primary project components, a general schedule for the Project, and reasons for selecting the Project site.

Federal Permitting

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) is the lead agency responsible for permitting the Project. The Federal Permitting station presents information about the three-stage process for permitting, how to submit formal comments to FERC, and information related to environmental and social resources to be considered during the permitting of the Project.

Project Needs and Benefits

The Project Needs and Benefits station explains the nature, necessity, and anticipated benefits of the Project.
