Conduct seasonal wildlife monitoring along the shore of Lake McConaughy, Keith County, Nebraska:

- Conduct field surveys of nesting least terns and piping plovers.
- Locate and monitor least tern and piping plover nests.
- Maintain daily observational records.
- Help with limnology monitoring on District properties.
- Other activities as needed.

Conduct habitat maintenance and enhancement activities pertaining to licensing conditions:

- Construct nest enclosures to protect nests from disturbance.
- Maintain nest areas on District properties.
- Fence construction

Conduct other maintenance duties on district property as needed:

- Mowing
- Noxious weed and vegetation control
